2021 was another eventful year for Aspire 3D. We continued to walk alongside residents and learn more about their ever changing needs. We recognized the opportunity for additional low-barrier services inside the apartment communities that can help residents thrive. This resulted in on-site food pantries to remove barriers to accessing healthy food, an Innovation Station to immerse youth in STEM concepts, and a Vocational Program to assist residents seeking new career fields because of COVID. We continued to provide space for our community partners to meet with residents and collaborate with our front line staff. We also carried out our first Kite Festival, with the support of several sponsors and a few thousand community members. Our team continues to evaluate the needs in our community and the role we can play with partners in order to promote the wellbeing, independence, and economic security of all our neighbors in Loveland. We appreciate the continued partnership, support, and collaboration that makes this possible!

Carried out First Annual Kite Festival with over 3,000 participants

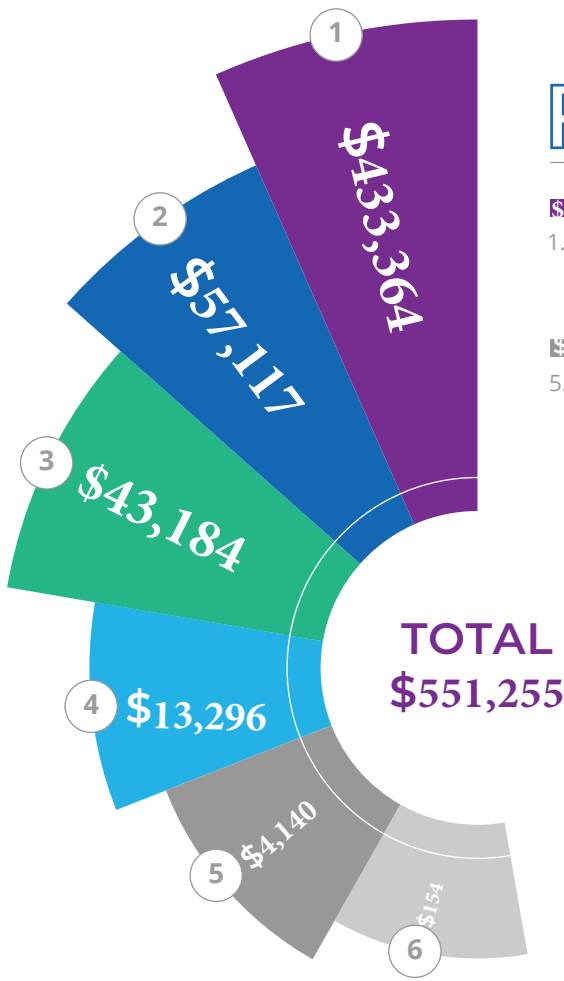

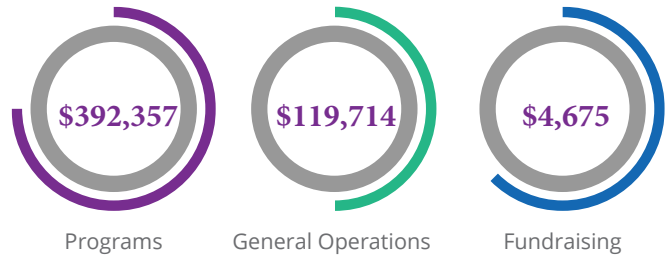
